ABOUT US:

The Central Library of Indian Institute of Technology (Indian School of Mines) Dhanbad is the heart of the institute providing direct academic and research supports to all departments.

The Central Library is an automated library in terms of records organization and management of all its different sections, search and discovery, information retrieval and service delivery. The whole library operations run on integrated library management software. Over the years the library has developed several databases of books, journals, theses/dissertations, conference proceedings, etc. All documents have been bar-coded. Focus has been given on the collection build-up of print resources as well as licensed e-resources plus E-Shodh Sindhu sponsored resources. Library's e-Resources are accessible from all the departments, hostels, and quarters on the campus wide LAN.

The library has initiated the development of the "Institutional Digital Repository" based on DSpace open source platform. The Central Library has set up its "Research Documentation Cell" based on the research outputs, which are indexed in Scopus and Web of Science.

To meet the challenges of an increasing number of students, research scholars, and faculty members as well as ever-changing information and communication technologies, a centrally air-conditioned library built state-of-the-art facilities to provide high-quality library services.

The library staff strives their best to help and push the boundaries of IIT (ISM) Dhanbad in national and international spaces.

LIBRARY RULES IN BRIEF:

- All the library users bring their ID cards before entering the library.
- Users should leave their bags, borrowed books and other belongings including personal books (except money and other valuables) at the property counter.
- Only two notebooks & one laptops will be allowed inside the library except 4th floor ORH.
- Smoking, spitting and using mobile phone inside the library are strictly prohibited.
- Books or other materials taken from the stacks should not be re-shelved by the users themselves. Please leave it on the tables to avoid misfiling. *Remember that "A book misplaced is a book lost".*
- The library users should not deface, mark, cut, mutilate or damage library materials in any way. If anyone is found doing so, h/s will be charged with the full replacement cost of damaged material leading to suspension of library account and debarred from entering the library as well as disciplinary action against him/her.
- The library users may be examined by the library staff/security personnel while leaving the library.
- Every library user has a right to a peaceful environment for reading. Please make sure that you are not violating this right of other users.
- All users are requested to keep their mobiles in silent mode inside the library.
- No visitor or guest is permitted to use the library without the prior permission of the library authority.
- All library users are advised to enter the library premises in a decent dress.
- The library users are advised to interact with the library staff for assistance related to library services.
- The library authority may cancel the membership of a library user and refuse entry to a user who violates the rules of the library or indulges in any type of misconduct.
